

PORT TRANSPORT

For transport to the Seafarers' Centre please call the control room on +44 (0)1375 648595.

The Seafarers' Centre can also be accessed on foot from the vessel. Please ensure you are wearing a hi-vis jacket and follow the green marked pathway. The distance from the furthest berth (No 3) is approximately 1 mile.

The centre is located on the ground floor of the amenities building; access details & codes will be provided to vessels on arrival in Port.

Port Chaplains make periodic visits to the centre and can be contacted on the numbers on the front cover.

If you wish to leave the port please ensure that security has a copy of your ship's crew list. Then call the control office on +44 (0)1375 648595 for a port shuttle bus to take you from the vessel or Seafarers' Centre to No.1 building.

If you wish to visit the London Tilbury Seafarers Centre transport can be provided. Please call +44 (0)1375 840454 when you have cleared security. Please be aware that it may take at least 30 minutes to travel from the ship to arriving at Tilbury.

Stanford-Le-Hope is the nearest town to the DP World London Gateway Port.

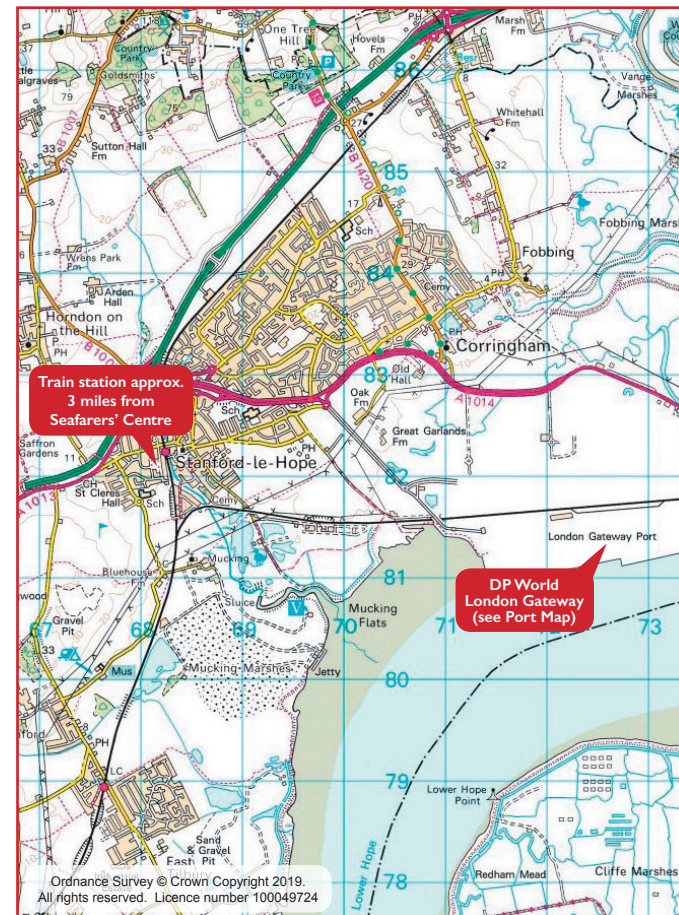
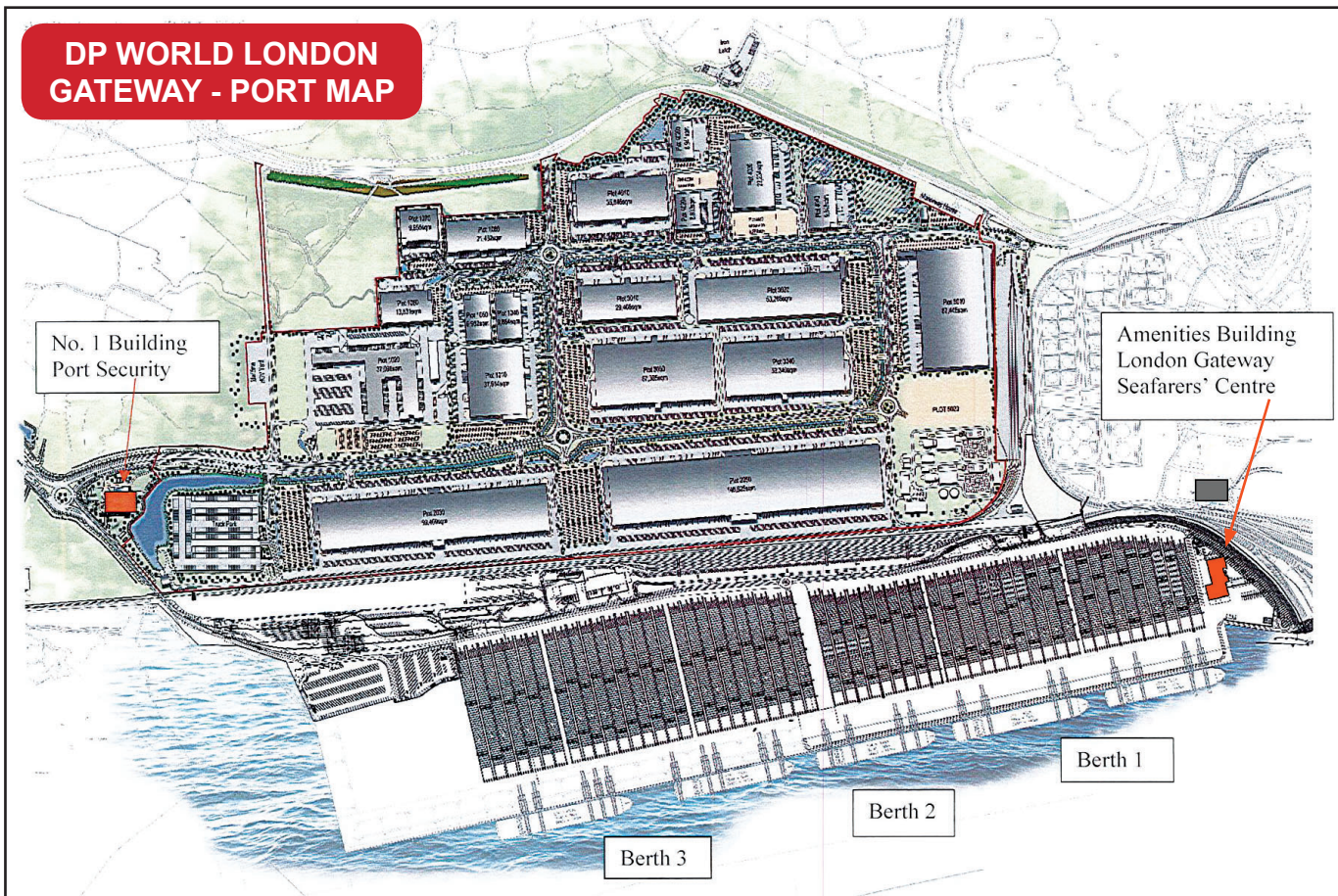
